### **CALL TO WORSHIP**

- C: Lord God, I know that you look at me through your perfect Son, my Savior, Jesus. Therefore, you see only his holiness and perfection. Because I am your child, I want to confess my sin:

I admit that I have too often taken for granted all you have done and are doing for me. I have come to expect, as my right, that things ought to go as I want them to go. I find it easy to complain when they don't. I have shown ungratefulness to you, dear Lord, in my thoughts, words and actions. Forgive my sins, all of them, for the sake of Jesus. Lord, have mercy on me!

#### **ABSOLUTION**

M: God wants us to see ourselves as he sees us. We are not just sinful human beings, but we are a new creation, forgiven and restored through the cleansing of Jesus' sacrifice. Our Savior doesn't look to find fault with us, but to carry our faults upon himself and to pay for them all with his life on the cross. When he died our sins, all of them, were buried with him. Jesus arose from the dead and proved that all our sins are covered.

I can say under the authority of and in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit that you are forgiven and you are given the right and the power to live as children of God!

## The Word

**FIRST LESSON** 

Deuteronomy 8:10-18

hen you have eaten and are satisfied, praise the LORD your God for the good land he has given you. <sup>11</sup> Be careful that you do not forget the LORD your God, failing to observe his commands, his laws and his decrees that I am giving you this day. <sup>12</sup> Otherwise, when you eat and are satisfied, when you build fine houses and settle down, <sup>13</sup> and when your herds and flocks grow large and your silver and gold increase and all you have is multiplied, <sup>14</sup> then your heart will become proud and you will forget the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. <sup>15</sup> He led you through the vast and dreadful desert, that thirsty and waterless land, with its venomous snakes and scorpions. He brought you water out of hard rock. <sup>16</sup> He gave you manna to eat in the desert, something your fathers had never known, to humble and to test you so that in the end it might go well with you. <sup>17</sup> You may say to yourself, "My power and the strength of my hands have produced this wealth for me." <sup>18</sup> But remember the LORD your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your forefathers, as it is today.

SECOND LESSON Philippians 4:10-20

rejoice greatly in the Lord that at last you have renewed your concern for me. Indeed, you have been concerned, but you had no opportunity to show it. <sup>11</sup> I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. <sup>12</sup> I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. <sup>13</sup> I can do everything through him who gives me strength. <sup>14</sup> Yet it was good of you to share in my troubles. <sup>15</sup> Moreover, as you Philippians know, in the early days of your acquaintance with the gospel, when I set out from Macedonia, not one church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving, except you only; <sup>16</sup> for even when I was in Thessalonica, you sent me aid again and again when I was in need. <sup>17</sup> Not that I am looking for a gift, but I am looking for what may be credited to your account. <sup>18</sup> I have received full payment and even more; I am amply supplied, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent. They are a fragrant offering, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. <sup>19</sup> And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus. <sup>20</sup> To our God and Father be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

**GOSPEL** Luke 17:11-19

M: The Gospel according to Luke chapter 17.

ow on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. <sup>12</sup> As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance <sup>13</sup> and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" <sup>14</sup> When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed. <sup>15</sup> One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. <sup>16</sup> He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan. <sup>17</sup> Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? <sup>18</sup> Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" <sup>19</sup> Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."

If electronic giving isn't for you, you are invited to drop off or mail your offerings to the church.


#### PRAYER OF THE CHURCH1
