Restrooms are in the entrance and through the nursery hallway.




- Handicapped accessible restroom facilities are located through the nursery hallway and back in the preschool area.

# THE WORD OF GOD\*



THE FIRST LESSON: EPHESIANS 2:13-22

The Ephesian Church was made up of both Jew and Gentile converts. But despite their different backgrounds and cultures, they were all called in faith to be one in Christ. Even though the Church is made up of many, Christ is the head of his Church.

But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

<sup>14</sup>For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, <sup>15</sup>by setting aside in his flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace, <sup>16</sup>and in one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility. <sup>17</sup>He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. <sup>18</sup>For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

<sup>19</sup>Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household, <sup>20</sup>built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. <sup>21</sup>In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. <sup>22</sup>And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit. (NIV)

### THE SECOND LESSON: MARK 6:30-34

As the popularity of Jesus grew, more and more people came from all over to hear his message of salvation. Jesus viewed them as lost souls, as sheep without a shepherd, and had compassion on them.

The apostles gathered around Jesus and reported to him all they had done and taught. <sup>31</sup>Then, because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat, he said to them, "Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest."

<sup>32</sup>So they went away by themselves in a boat to a solitary place. <sup>33</sup>But many who saw them leaving recognized them and ran on foot from all the towns and got there ahead of them. <sup>34</sup>When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things. (NIV)

### SERMON TEXT: JEREMIAH 23:1-6

It was a time when the spiritual leaders of Israel had become corrupt and had turned the people away from the Lord. Despite their great wickedness, Jeremiah pictures a Savior, who would one day come to be a good shepherd to his people gathering his people in faith unto eternity.

"Woe to the shepherds who are destroying and scattering the sheep of my pasture!" declares the Lord. <sup>2</sup>Therefore this is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says to the shepherds who tend my people: "Because you have scattered my flock and driven them away and have not bestowed care on them, I will bestow punishment on you for the evil you have done," declares the Lord. <sup>3</sup>"I myself will gather the remnant of my flock out of all the countries where I have driven them and will bring them back to their pasture, where they will be fruitful and increase in number. <sup>4</sup>I will place shepherds over them who will tend them, and they will no longer be afraid or terrified, nor will any be missing," declares the Lord.

<sup>5</sup>"The days are coming," declares the Lord, "when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, a King who will reign wisely and do what is just and right in the land. <sup>6</sup>In his days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety. This is the name by which he will be called: The Lord Our Righteous Savior. (NIV)




