




- Handicapped accessible restroom facilities are located through the nursery hallway and back in the preschool area.



The Word of God



The First Lesson: Numbers 6:22-27

God commanded the Israelite priests (the Levites) to put a blessing of his old testament people. In so doing, the name of the Lord is proclaimed three times, once for each person of the Triune God.

The Lord said to Moses, ²³"Tell Aaron and his sons, 'This is how you are to bless the Israelites. Say to them:

²⁴" '"The Lord bless you

and keep you;

²⁵the Lord make his face shine on you

and be gracious to you;

²⁶the Lord turn his face toward you

and give you peace."

²⁷"So they will put my name on the Israelites, and I will bless them."


