




- Handicapped accessible restroom facilities are located through the nursery hallway and back in the preschool area.

# The Word of God



The First Lesson: Jeremiah 23:23-39

Even though the false prophets of Baal tried to get the people of Isreal to abandon the Lord and forget his name, the Lord would yet remain. His Word forever stands to the nations of this world as a testimony of his power, justice, and mercy.

"Am I only a God nearby," declares the Lord, "and not a God far away?

24Who can hide in secret places so that I cannot see them?" declares the Lord.


"Do not I fill heaven and earth?" declares the Lord.

<sup>25</sup>"I have heard what the prophets say who prophesy lies in my name. They say, 'I had a dream! I had a dream!' <sup>26</sup>How long will this continue in the hearts of these lying prophets, who prophesy the delusions of their own minds? <sup>27</sup>They think the dreams they tell one another will make my people forget my name, just as their ancestors forgot my name through Baal worship. <sup>28</sup>Let the prophet who has a dream recount the dream, but let the one who has my word speak it faithfully. For what has straw to do with grain?" declares the Lord. <sup>29</sup>"Is not my word like fire," declares the Lord, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?

<sup>30</sup>"Therefore," declares the Lord, "I am against the prophets who steal from one another words supposedly from me. <sup>31</sup>Yes," declares the Lord, "I am against the prophets who wag their own tongues and yet declare, 'The Lord declares.' <sup>32</sup>Indeed, I am against those who prophesy false dreams," declares the Lord. "They tell them and lead my people astray with their reckless lies, yet I did not send or appoint them. They do not benefit these people in the least," declares the Lord.

<sup>33</sup>"When these people, or a prophet or a priest, ask you, 'What is the message from the Lord?' say to them, 'What message? I will forsake you, declares the Lord.' <sup>34</sup>If a prophet or a priest or anyone else claims, 'This is a message from the Lord,' I will punish them and their household. <sup>35</sup>This is what each of you keeps saying to your friends and other Israelites: 'What is the Lord's answer?' or 'What has the Lord spoken?' <sup>36</sup>But you must not mention 'a message from the Lord' again, because each one's word becomes their own message. So you distort the words of the living God, the Lord Almighty, our God. <sup>37</sup>This is what you keep saying to a prophet: 'What is the Lord's answer to you?' or 'What has the Lord spoken?' <sup>38</sup>Although you claim, 'This is a message from the Lord,' this is what the Lord says: You used the words, 'This is a message from the Lord,' even though I told you that you must not claim, 'This is a message from the Lord.' <sup>39</sup>Therefore, I will surely forget you and cast you out of my presence along with the city I gave to you and your ancestors.

### The Second Lesson: Luke 12:49-53


The peace Jesus came to bring was not an earthly peace, but to establish peace between sinners and a holy God. The only way to accomplish this peace was through his suffering and death, being the sacrifice for our sins. It is only faith in Jesus the saves, a faith that can often divide earthly households but to those who believe, there is the certainty of salvation.

"I have come to bring fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled! <sup>50</sup>But I have a baptism to undergo, and what constraint I am under until it is completed! <sup>51</sup>Do you think I came to bring peace on earth? No, I tell you, but division. <sup>52</sup>From now on there will be five in one family divided against each other, three against two and two against three. <sup>53</sup>They will be divided, father against son and son against father, mother against daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against daughter-in-law against mother-in-law."

### **Sermon Text: Hebrews 12:1-13**

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, <sup>2</sup>fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. <sup>3</sup>Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

<sup>4</sup>In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. <sup>5</sup>And have you completely forgotten this word of encouragement that addresses you as a father addresses his son? It says,

"My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline,

and do not lose heart when he rebukes you,

<sup>6</sup>because the Lord disciplines the one he loves,

and he chastens everyone he accepts as his son."


<sup>7</sup>Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as his children. For what children are not disciplined by their father? <sup>8</sup>If you are not disciplined—and everyone undergoes discipline—then you are not legitimate, not true sons and daughters at all. <sup>9</sup>Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of spirits and live! <sup>10</sup>They disciplined us for a little while as they thought best; but God disciplines us for our good, in order that we may share in his holiness. <sup>11</sup>No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.

<sup>12</sup>Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. <sup>13</sup>"Make level paths for your feet," so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed.


